#### 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: Irritating to eyes.

#### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES - Symptoms

**Skin Contact:** There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact.  
**Eye Contact:** There may be pain and redness. The eyes may water profusely. There may be severe pain.  
The vision may become blurred. May cause permanent damage.

**Inhalation:** Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

#### 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES.

**Suitable extinguishing media:** Suitable extinguishing media for the surrounding fire should be used. Use water spray to cool containers.  
**Exposure Hazards:** In combustion emits toxic fumes.  
**Protection of Fire Fighters:** Wear self contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.





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## 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES.

**Personal precautions:** Mark out the contaminated area with signs and prevent access to unauthorised personnel, Do not attempt to take action without suitable protective clothing – see section 8 of SDS. Turn leaking containers leak-side up to prevent escape of liquid.

**Environmental precautions:** Do not discharge into drains or rivers. Contain the spillage using bunding.

**Clean-up Procedures:** Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate method.

**Handling Requirements:** Avoid direct contact with the substance. Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area. Avoid the formation or spread of mists in the air.
